Bart P. Leroy: Prof. Leroy is Chairman and Head of the Department of Ophthalmology, and Staff Member at the Center for Medical Genetics at the Ghent University Hospital in Belgium. He is Professor of Ophthalmology, Ophthalmic Genetics & Visual Electrophysiology at Ghent University and also serves as an attending physician at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, PA, USA. Prof. Leroy's research focus is mainly on genetic eye disease, including inherited retinal dystrophies and ocular developmental disease. Prof. Leroy was involved in the development of voretigene neparvovec and is the PI for several gene and genetic therapy trials for inherited retinal blindness.
