

Prof. Francesca Simonelli, University of Campania Luigi Vanvitelli, Napoli, Italy

Francesca Simonelli was born in Nola (Naples), Italy, in 1959. She received a Degree in Medicine and Surgery from the University of Naples Federico II, Naples, Italy, in 1983, and Residency in Ophthalmology from the School of Medicine, University of Naples Federico II, in 1987.

She is currently Full Professor of Ophthalmology at the Multidisciplinary Department of Medical, Surgical and Dental Sciences, University of Campania Luigi Vanvitelli, Naples, Italy. She has authored or co-authored about 250 journal and conference papers in Ophthalmology. Prof. Simonelli is Chief of the Eye Clinic, of the School of Specialization in Ophthalmology, of the Centre of Rare Ocular Diseases, and of the Unit for Advanced Ocular Therapy at the University of Campania Luigi Vanvitelli.

Prof. Simonelli is a member of the Association for Research in Vision and Ophthalmology, President of the Italian Society of Ophthalmologic Genetics, member of the National Fighting Blindness Committee of the Italian Ministry of Health, of the Regional Committee for Rare Diseases, and of the Italian Society of Ophthalmology, and President of the Scientific Committee of Retina Italia Onlus.
