Assoc. Prof. Mirjana Bjeloš is subspecialist in pediatric ophthalmology and strabismus. Her field of interest is pediatric ophthalmology, strabismus, inherited retinal dystrophies and electrophysiology of the eye. She is the head of the Reference Center of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Croatia for Pediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus, at the Department of Ophthalmology, Clinical Hospital "Sveti Duh" in Zagreb (2015 – ongoing), and the director of the Collaborative Center of the World Health Organization for Pediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus at the Reference Center for Pediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus (2019 – ongoing). She is the head of a multidisciplinary team for the application of gene therapy at the Certified Center of the Department of Ophthalmology at the University Hospital "Sveti Duh", which in July 2020 became the sixth center for gene therapy in ophthalmology in the world.
