

Prof. Helene Dollfus, Strasbourg University Hospital, France

Hélène Dollfus is an MD PhD with two medical specialties: ophthalmology and medical genetics. She is a professor in medical genetics at the university of Strasbourg and consultant at the Strasbourg University Hospital (PU-PH) where she is the head of the medical genetics department and the coordinator: 1° of the rare disease centre for rare eye diseases (CRM R CARGO), 2° of the French network for sensorial diseases (FSMR SENSGENE) 3° of the European Reference Network for Rare Eye Disease (ERN-EYE). She is also the director of the mixed INSERM University of Strasbourg research laboratory (UMRS_1112) in which she supervises the research group "Pheno-Gen". She is the lead for the Alsacian Institute of Medical Genetics (IGMA) and the recipient of prizes such as the grand prix Robert Debré and the Prix recherche INSERM.
